Mrs. Mattie Langley Dies in Thomasville; Services Sunday

Mrs. Mattie Herring Langley, 69, died at 1:53 a. m. in Archbold Memorial Hospital on Saturday, April 8, following a long illness. Funeral services were held at 3 p. m. Sunday, April 9, at the Calvary Methodist Church with Rev. J. O. Corbitt and Rev. Max Hughes officiating. Interment followed in the Piedmont Cemetery.
